FROM 60 TO 118:

WHEN IMPACT EXCEEDS EXPECTATIONS

Training sessions from the ITG project empower more than double the number of young entrepreneurs in Eastern Europe.

The ITG – InTechGrowth project confirms its real impact on the ground with a result that exceeds all initial expectations: out of the 60 young people expected to receive training, 118 ultimately participated in the capacity-building activities.

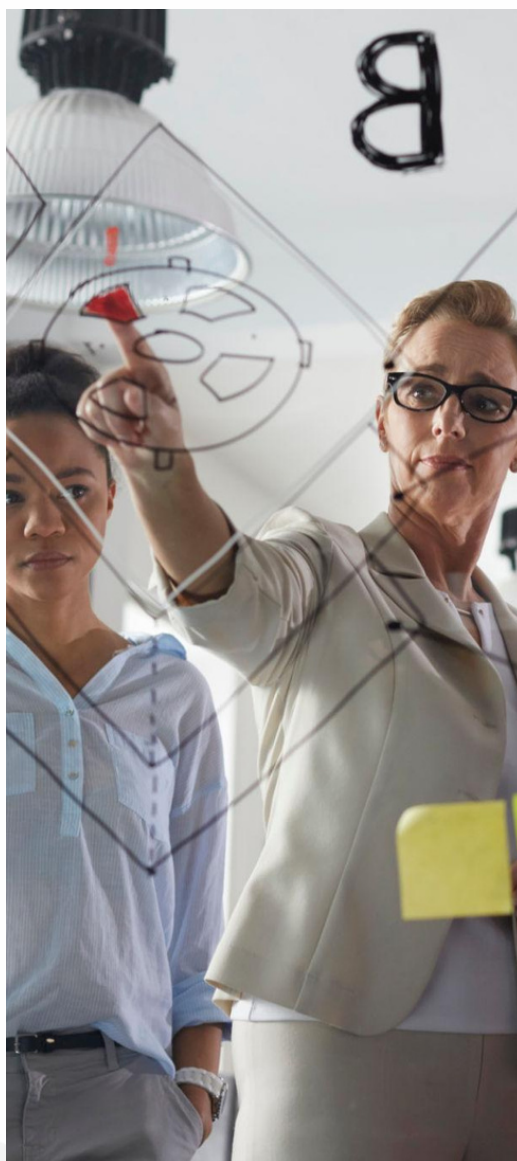
This result is no coincidence. It reflects the interest, motivation, and need that exist among young people in Georgia, Moldova, Ukraine, and Azerbaijan to access real opportunities for professional development.

The training sessions, designed and conducted by the project partners, offered content tailored to the needs identified in prior research. Far from being generic training, specific, practical, and action-oriented materials were created.

Furthermore, all resources used during the sessions are available for free on the project platform, allowing the impact to extend beyond direct participants and ensuring the sustainability of the results.

Throughout the training, the young participants not only acquired technical knowledge but also strengthened key skills such as creativity, self-confidence, and the ability to turn ideas into concrete projects.

The success in participation demonstrates that when suitable and accessible tools are provided, young talent responds with commitment, energy, and a vision for the future
