The InTechGrowth project has taken an important step forward with the holding of its first in-person event in Poland. **This meeting** brought together representatives from various organizations and young entrepreneurs with the goal of strengthening business and technological skills, fostering the creation and development of innovative startups.

A Space for Learning and Collaboration

The event featured experts in entrepreneurship and education, who shared their knowledge and experiences in developing technology startups. Activities included practical workshops, roundtables, and networking sessions, facilitating the exchange of ideas and best practices among attendees.

One of the highlights was the presentation, which addressed key strategies for strengthening the youth entrepreneurial ecosystem and the importance of international cooperation in this area.

Key Objectives of the InTechGrowth Project

- Strengthening digital and entrepreneurial skills in young people from non-Erasmus+ partner countries.
- Improving cooperation between educational institutions and youth organizations, promoting synergies for greater impact.
- Promoting the development of technology startups through innovative strategies and approaches tailored to the needs of today's market.

A project of international scope

With the collaboration of nine partners from different countries, InTechGrowth is expanding its impact globally, including the participation of four countries outside the Erasmus+ program. The cooperation between these entities enables the transfer of knowledge and the adaptation of working methodologies to different social and economic contexts.
